Improvements to the Alton Village Hall Playing Field and Play Area

Alton Parish Council is pleased to share a proposed list of improvements for the Village Park, to be funded by a grant via the District Council under Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. These funds must be spent on improvements to the playing field and play area at the village hall site.

We are committed to ensuring this funding is used in a way that reflects the needs and wishes of Alton residents. These enhancements aim to improve safety, accessibility, and enjoyment for all users of the park.

The proposed works include:

Repainting of existing play equipment

Installation of safety mulch beneath the Central Fort and Zip Wire (due to drop height)

Repair or replacement of the soft-close gate to meet ROSPA standards

Addition of a new cradle swing and spring tractor (replacing the maze game)

Replacement of the zip wire line and seat

Installation of safety matting below existing swings

Installation of new perimeter safety fencing (full or partial replacement)

Addition of a litter bin and possible extra seating

A dedicated committee has been formed to oversee the planning and progress of this project and to consider community feedback. Meetings are held periodically and will be advertised on the village noticeboard.
